facilities and services

Living at Murdoch University Village offers access to a range of facilities and services to help you make the most of uni life!

The Village's on-site facilities are designed to support your social and academic needs.

Boardroom (Building 93)

The Boardroom is located in the Study Centre and contains a large table, whiteboard and internet connectivity. It can be booked for group study sessions by contacting the Resident Life Manager on +61 8 9360 2098.

E-library (Building 93)

The E-library is located in the Study Centre and offers 24-hour access (via Village swipe card) to computers and partitioned areas for quiet study.

Movie Room (Building 93)

The Movie Room is located in the Study Centre and features a television, DVD player, Foxtel and laptop connectivity. Residents can access the room 24 hours a day via Village swipe card.

Laundry (Village North - next to the Pool Lounge, Village South - Buildings 7, 26 and 81)

The laundries offer coin-operated washers and dryers. Machines take three \$1 coins per wash. Change is available at the Administration and Resident Assistant Offices during opening hours.

Pool Lounge and Decking (Village North)

The Pool Lounge offers BBQ facilities, a pool table, TV with Foxtel and vending machines.

Recreation Room (Building 82)

The Recreation Room is perfect for group gatherings, containing a sound system with iPod connectivity, projection screen, pool table, communal cooking facilities and BBQs.

Village Sports Oval (near the Recreation Room)

Volleyball courts, basketball courts and a grassed area are available for casual and competitive games. Sports equipment can be borrowed for free from the Resident Assistant Office.

Study Hub (Building 12)

The Hub offers 24-hour swipe card access to partitioned study zones with wireless internet connectivity.

Swimming Pool (Village North)

The swimming pool is located in a central courtyard and is open from 7:00am to 10:00pm daily.

Wattle Seminar Room (Village North)

Ideal for large group study sessions, the seminar room features ample seating and table space, a whiteboard, projection screen and internet connectivity. It can be booked for group study sessions by contacting the Resident Life Manager on +61 8 9360 2098.

getting around

All public transport services are managed by Transperth, including buses, trains and ferries. Visit www.transperth.wa.gov.au or call 13 62 13 for more information.

A valid Transperth ticket doesn't just entitle you to a single ride. It buys you up to three hours of travel on any Transperth bus, train and ferry service.

Transperth determines fares by dividing its services into zones. Fares are calculated by the number of zones you travel through during your journey.

Services run between the following hours:

Monday to Thursday (5:00am to 12:30am)

Friday and Saturday (5:00am to 2:00am)

Sunday and public holidays (5:00am to 12:00am)

Two types of tickets are available, Smartrider or cash tickets.

Smartrider

Smartrider is Transperth's electronic ticketing system. We recommend using Smartrider tickets as it ensures that you pay the appropriate and lowest fare. Cards can be

purchased at any Transperth InfoCentre or SmartRider retail sales outlet.

Initial purchase fee: \$10 (standard)
\$5 (concession)

A minimum of \$10 must be added to your SmartRider.

Cash tickets

Individual cash tickets can also be purchased from the driver for bus travel, or from Ticket Vending Machines (TVMs) located at all train stations. Ferry passengers can purchase tickets from the driver or the TVM at the jetty.

Remember to look after your ticket and ensure it is valid for your trip. Also remember to take the ticket with you when transferring between services. Fines exist for those who are not carrying valid tickets.
