Murdoch University Village (Campus Living Villages Murdoch Pty Ltd, ABN: 99 123 217 809) invites future students to apply for the Murdoch University Village Scholarship Program. Ten accommodation scholarships are available to first year students who are planning to enrol in an undergraduate course of study at Murdoch University in 2010. Accommodation will be in a twin share room and the scholarship funds cannot be used to upgrade to another room type.

The Murdoch University Village Scholarship Program will cover the residential fees for either a 21 or 42 week contract period, to a maximum of 8 February to 28 November 2010 at Murdoch University Village (total value of \$3,990 per student). The Scholarship Program does not cover additional fees such as utilities, the application fee and the residential program fee.

NOTE: Successful students will not personally receive the funding but will have their accommodation costs paid directly by Murdoch University Village.

eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the Murdoch University Village Scholarship, students must:

- Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- Be a Year 12 School leaver in 2008 or 2009;
- Provide proof of financial hardship in the form of a Centrelink Income Statement;
- Be prepared to commence full-time studies in a first year undergraduate course at Murdoch University in 2010;
- Be prepared to enter into a residential agreement with Murdoch University Village for a twin share room in 2010; and
- Have achieved a UAI (or equivalent) of 70.00 or greater

required documentation

All applicants will be required to attach the following:

- Copies of school reports for Year 11 and 12;
- Centrelink Income Statement
- A personal statement (maximum 500 words typed) demonstrating what you hope to achieve during your University career, any extracurricular activities/work experience you believe will help you achieve your goals and why you believe you are a suitable candidate for the scholarship.

other eligibility criteria + conditions of entry

- All recipients of scholarships will be determined by Murdoch University Village based upon the eligibility criteria outlined above and each of the following assessment criteria:
 - Financial situation
 - Academic achievement (based on provided high school grades)
 - Dedication to course of study (based on extracurricular activities, work experience, future goals etc)
 - Grammar and writing style
- Not all candidates meeting these criteria will necessarily be awarded scholarships.
- Murdoch University Village reserves the right to not award scholarships in a year if no candidates are considered suitable by the scholarship selection panel.
- Successful students will not personally receive the funding but will have their accommodation costs paid directly by Murdoch University Village.
- Scholarship recipients must be enrolled as full-time students and must reside at Murdoch University Village for the year the scholarship has been awarded. Part-time and distance learning applicants are not eligible.
- Applicants must hold current Australian citizenship or permanent residency. Murdoch University Village retains the right to be the final arbiter of an applicant's eligibility.
- If a scholarship recipient terminates their residential agreement with Murdoch University Village, withdraws from their course of study, leaves university altogether or otherwise breaches the specific criteria of eligibility as listed above, their scholarship will be terminated with immediate effect and all rental payments ceased.
- Scholarships may be terminated if Murdoch University Village determines the following:
 - Unsatisfactory academic performance (such as falling below the required academic standards to pass their course at Murdoch University)
 - The recipient acts in a way so as to bring Campus Living Villages Pty Ltd, Murdoch University Village or Murdoch University into disrepute.
- Campus Living Villages and Murdoch University Village may publish or publicise information, including winners' names, in mediums including but not limited to the University's website, the Campus Living Villages or Murdoch University Village website and newspapers.
